- Initiate and foster relationships with points of contact at schools, businesses and organizations that partake in our programs as donors, volunteers or sponsors
- Process and manage individual and group applications for assistance for educational essentials and extra-curricular enrichment through A Precious Child's Edusentials, giveSPORTS and giveARTS Programs
- Work with the Resource Center to determine highest need items and research potential in-kind drive prospects in order to receive these items
- Manage all in-kind drives regarding outreach, driver logistics and scheduling, and post-drive follow-up
- Conduct follow-up and coordination with clients and agency partners in regards to A Precious Child's scholarship programs
- Programs related data entry while maintaining accurate records within our database
- Manage A Precious Child's Inspiring Minds Center through staffing, purchasing, and data entry
- Research, purchase materials and distribute Inspiring Minds Center STEM Kits to children in the Inspiring Minds Center and through Agency Partner relationships
- Support program volunteers and interns
- Support development efforts in regards to programming
- Adhere to organizational safety and OSHA standards
- Supervise and support program staff, volunteers and interns including volunteer groups
- Other duties as assigned
