A Precious Child is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization devoted to providing children in need with opportunities and resources to empower them to achieve their full potential.

Description:

The Programs Intern will have the opportunity to assist with planning and implementation of eight A Precious Child Programs. As well as aid with development and implementation of new potential programs.

Responsibilities:

- Work directly with the Programs Manager and Programs Team to collaborate, prep, run, and evaluate our operational programs.
- Initiate and keep relationships with points of contact at schools, businesses and organizations that partake in our programs as donors, volunteers, or sponsors
- Developing and implementing tracking systems
- Researching and applying for in-kind donations of needed items
- Aid in execution of A Precious Child's three scholarship programs including processing applications and fulfilling scholarship requests
- Assisting with solicitation of corporate sponsorships for programs
- Assisting with coordinating distribution of goods to families and agency partners in relation to each program

Qualifications:

- Graduate student or experienced undergraduate in relevant field (Social Work, Project Management, Business, Psychology, Sociology, Counseling, Education etc.)
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Self-motivated, good organizational skills, flexibility, collaborative skills, and able to multi-task and works well with people
- Ability to work with a wide range of people and show sensitivity to individual differences
- Ability to communicate in a professional manner with other staff members, volunteers, and clients
- Spanish/English Bilingual is preferred
- Enthusiasm for the mission of A Precious Child and the children and families we serve
