The Community Engagement Intern will report to the Volunteer Manager to run and maintain the Volunteer Department at A Precious Child. This position will be responsible for assisting with volunteer outreach and recruitment, onsite volunteer operations including running volunteer check in, volunteer training, special event volunteer coordination, volunteer appreciation events and administrative and data entry work.

Reports To: Volunteer Manager

Hours: At least two shifts a week with a minimum time commitment of 8-10 hours a week.

Areas of Responsibilities:

- Work with the Volunteer Manager to execute department plans and objectives;
- Assist Volunteer Team with volunteer outreach and recruitment efforts;
- Represent A Precious Child at tabling events;
- Researching new places to post online opportunities or speak to individuals about volunteering;
- Helping Volunteer Team run volunteer check in and check out of volunteer shifts throughout the day;
- Assist with coordination, management and training of special event and seasonal volunteers;
- Work with Volunteer Team to set up and run Volunteer Orientations;
- Assist with new volunteer onboarding's in all departments;
- Assist with data entry projects as needed;
