Summary: The role of our Precious Mentor Peer Mentors is to support at-risk middle school students in their academic achievement and relationship skill building.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Can dedicate at least one academic year to their mentee.
- Can dedicate one hour and fifteen minutes per week to meet virtually with their mentee.
- Commit to being a positive role model and having a positive attitude with your mentee.
- Work to connect with your mentee, understand the struggles your mentee is facing and offer support through good and challenging times.
- Attend additional special events hosted by A Precious Child in regards to the Mentor Program.
- Provide positive guidance and constructive feedback for the program.

Requirements:

- Must have Volunteer Waiver Form completed.
- Must have parent sign off for participation in the program on application form.

Training & Supervision:

- Initial training will be provided by Precious Mentor Manager and additional A Precious Child staff.

Time Commitment:

- Mentors must be able to commit one hour and fifteen minutes per week virtually
 - 2022/2023 meetings will take place on Wednesday or Thursday from 4:15 - 5:30
- Mentors must be able to commit to **one academic year** with their mentee. (September to May)
